

17.14h Meeting Opened at Sutus Court

- 1. March MMM Minutes approved with no changes
- 2. Committee is generally satisfied with the outcome of the last two runs. Some concern was expressed about the relatively low turnout for Run 491.
- 3. Financial Report
 - Run 488 small profit
 - Run 489 large profit
 - Run 490 moderate profit
 - Run 491 large profit

The Jungle Hash has a total cash balance of 83,520\$, helped by Shirt sponsorship.

- 4. Rags has an inventory of 37 shirts ranging in size from S to 4XL with a value of 27,850\$. The club is holding a stock of 37 pairs of socks that will be reduced from 80 to 50\$, hopefully encouraging sales. Based on the 20th Anniversary Run registrations so far, 40 shirts will be ordered from PrintSpace now, to avoid SongKran production problems.
- 5. Hareline report: Things are going well. People are coming forward to volunteer without coercion. Hareline is full through May. The Hareraiser submitted a written letter to the committee describing his approach to encouraging Hare volunteers. His viewpoints were generally well received.
- 6. Special Runs:
 - 20 Year Anniversary May 5-7
 - Chimps Night Out (Friday 5/5) Meet at Four K YA 2 Bar. This will facilitate registration for the weekend's festivities.
 - Anniversary Jungle Run (Saturday 6/5) A-Site is Asian University to be hared by the superstar team of Wild Wolf and Shit Caroline.(NCBF)
 - Sunday Strollers (Sunday 7/5) Meeting at the Teacher's Lounge
 - 500th Run will be on the 3rd Saturday of August (19/8)
- 7. Transport is all good. The committee unanimously expressed continuing appreciation for the work G.I. Joe & Squeeze my Tube do to make this happen.
- 8. Communication: French Erection has headed up an effort to take photos and upload them to the Jungle Facebook Group. Each of the three runs he has posted has garnered 80 likes on average. This engagement is seen as an excellent way to promote the club.
- 9. Marketing: Social media outlets (Facebook and Line) are the primary sources of engagement. Some debate was had about the necessity of maintaining the website which receives little traffic. It was decided for the time being to continue with all three outlets. Sponsorship has been received from 6 bars and Pattaya Printspace which will help with cost of shirts for the 20th Anniversary run.



- 10. Run Records: These will continue to be painstakingly updated on a monthly basis by Burl Ives.
- 11. Chimps Night Out will interrupt its regularly scheduled programming. The April meetup is being postponed to coincide with the 20th Anniversary Chimps Night on May 5.

 the prize table. It is believed that some good beer and wine will encourage
 more committee members to purchase tickets.
