- b) Electrolyte required for next run

- c) BI raised an issue with an incorrectly broken check during run 509. Hares to put sticks on the ground in first circle and show how to point arrows if we have out of towners at the run. Note this may not prevent a recurrence of this **ACTION CB**
- d) BI raised that if we have many out of towners we should have a sweeper to ensure safety of the pack. GM will ask for volunteer in first circle **ACTION GM**
- e) BI raised that we need some first aid supplies. STB volunteered to buy some basic supplies. Note it will be up to people to self administer due to potential liability issues

- f) BI raised that we need a committee check list for bigger runs **ACTION GM**
- g) BI raised that we need different coloured tickets so that we aren't limited to sales of 40 tickets on bigger runs, current stock of generic tickets is Blue, Green, Yellow, Pink

- h) GM raised that he got late advice (on Sunday) of people breaking the rules around beers on run 509, multiple beers were taken unopened and stowed away, culprits weren't recognised, most likely from out of town. As we only have beer on one side of the truck sadly we will need to ask for a beer checker for the larger runs where we have out of town people to try and minimise this from happening **ACTION GM**
